Specialist Disability Accommodation (known as 'SDA') are supports for you to live as independently as possible in a specially designed and built accommodation environment that specifically caters to your individual need because you cannot live 'well' and enable your independence within an ordinary house.

SDA is a separate support within the NDIS that is available to you if you meet the access requirements due to specialist needs related to your disability – these may be physical or behavioural.

To progress through the process, there are many people involved. You, your Support Coordinator and NDIS planner, architects, family members or nominees, health and medical professionals, SDA assessors, registered NDIS providers, builders and developers etc.

It can be a minefield to navigate the NDIS process and the interaction with and input from the many people involved. There are also:

- criteria to meet and access requirements to address to obtain SDA funded support for you.
- assessment and compliance for the built environment.
- a necessity to correctly inform the built environment to enable your independence and the provision of the right supports.
