About SIL supports

- How will you provide my SIL supports?
- How will you support me to reach my goals?
- Can I decide what, where, and when I receive supports?
- Will my support team teach me to learn new skills, like cooking for myself?
- Will I be included in helping out with the chores around the house?
- Can I change the types of supports I receive, and who can I talk to about doing that?
- How will my support team make sure I have a variety of things to do?
- Can I go to bed and wake up when I like?
- What do I do if I change my mind about the activities that have been planned?
- Who employs my support team, and how can I help choose my support workers?
- What happens if a support worker does something that I don't like?
- How many workers will be part of my support team?
- How will I know who's coming to support me, and will the same people support me all the time?

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About the SIL house

- Can I choose where I want to live and can you explain to me how I do that?
- Can I choose who I live with, and can you explain to me how I do that?
- Will you help me move out of where I am to somewhere I'd like to live?
- Do I get my own room, and can I lock my room?
- What are the things I need to pay for that are not covered by my NDIS funding?
- Who looks after the garden and the yard, and do I have to pay for that?
- Will my team support me to do my shopping?
- How is my money managed?
- Are there any house rules, and how are they decided?
- Can I keep my medication in my room?
- Can I have my own TV in my bedroom?
- What are the best times for my family to visit?
- Can I have a party or invite visitors over?
